This product is chemically acceptable for use as a cleaner for boilers, steam lines and cooling systems during shutdown (P1). All traces must be removed from the system before operation resumes in official establishments operating under the Federal meat and poultry products inspection program. The compound must be used in a manner which prevents direct or indirect contamination of edible products.
