This product is acceptable as a lubricant where there is no possibility of food contact (H2) in and around food processing areas. Such compounds may be used as lubricants, release agents, or antirust films on equipment and machine parts in locations in which there is no possibility of the lubricant or lubricated part contacting edible products.

This product is acceptable as an ingredient for use in lubricants with no food contact (HX-2). Such compounds may be used as lubricants, release agents, or antirust films on equipment and machine parts in locations where there is no possibility of the lubricant or lubricated part contacting edible products.

Formulations containing NSF Registered ingredients are not considered to be NSF Registered products. A separate application is required for each final product. Formulators using NSF Registered ingredients need only identify the trade name, the NSF Registration Number, and concentration within the finished product on the application form.
