NSF has processed the application for Registration of **DETSOL HDF** to the NSF Registration Guidelines for Proprietary Substances and Nonfood Compounds (2004), which are available at <http://www.nsf.org>. The NSF Nonfood Compounds Registration Program is a continuation of the USDA product approval and listing program, which is based on meeting regulatory requirements including FDA 21 CFR for appropriate use, ingredient review and labeling verification.

This product is acceptable for use as a general cleaner (A1) on all surfaces in and around food processing areas, where its use is not intended for direct food contact. Use of this product in food processing or handling facilities requires that all food products and packaging materials be removed or protected prior to product use. A potable water rinse of cleaned surfaces is required after use of this product. When used according to manufacturer's instructions, the cleaner shall neither exhibit a noticeable odor nor leave a visible residue.

Label review was not performed since only distributors market this formulation under their own names. This letter is the only confirmation that the formulation complies with the NSF Guidelines. At your request, the product will not be listed in the NSF White Book™ nor on the NSF website. The product's registration can be verified by contacting NSF directly. Distributors' brands can be sub-registered without disclosing the formulation by having distributors specify the NSF Registration Number in their applications.

Changes in formulation without the prior written consent of NSF will void registration.
