This product is acceptable for use as an ingredient in sewer and drain cleaners (LX) in and around food processing areas.

Limitations: This ingredient is acceptable for use in L2 cleaners. Use must also be consistent with the manufacturer's directions and warnings.

Formulations containing NSF Registered ingredients are not considered to be NSF Registered products. A separate application is required for each final product. Formulators using NSF Registered ingredients need only identify the trade name, the NSF Registration Number, and concentration within the finished product on the application form.

This product is acceptable as an ingredient for use in solvent cleaners (KX). Due to the nature of some ingredients, they may not be acceptable for use in some types of products. Formulations containing NSF Registered ingredients are not considered NSF Registered products. A separate application is required for each final product. Formulators using NSF Registered ingredients need only identify the trade name, NSF Registration number, and concentration within the finished product on the application form.

This product is acceptable as an ingredient for use in lubricants with no food contact (HX-2). Such compounds may be used as lubricants, release agents, or antirust films on equipment and machine parts in locations where there is no possibility of the lubricant or lubricated part contacting edible products.

Formulations containing NSF Registered ingredients are not considered to be NSF Registered products. A separate application is required for each final product. Formulators using NSF Registered ingredients need only identify the trade name, the NSF Registration Number, and concentration within the finished product on the application form.

This product is acceptable as an ingredient for use in antimicrobial agents (DX), provided that the finished antimicrobial product is appropriately registered with the EPA when sold within the United States. When used on equipment that will be returned to a food processing area, the product must be completely washed off and rinsed with potable water before returning to the processing area.

Formulations containing NSF Registered ingredients are not considered to be NSF Registered products. A separate application is required for each final product. Formulators using NSF Registered ingredients need only identify the trade name, the NSF Registration Number, and concentration within the finished product on the application form."

"This product is acceptable for use as an ingredient in cleaning products to be used in and around food processing areas (AX) where its use is not intended for direct food contact. The acceptable use level will vary based on the ingredients in the remainder of the formulation. Most use levels generally used for the purpose in industry would be acceptable.

Formulations containing NSF Registered ingredients are not considered to be NSF Registered products. A separate application is required for each final product. Formulators using NSF Registered ingredients need only identify the trade name, the NSF Registration Number, and concentration within the finished product on the application form."
