The NSF Nonfood Compounds Registration Program is a continuation of the USDA product approval and listing program, which is based on meeting regulatory requirements including FDA 21 CFR for appropriate use, ingredient and labeling review.

**This product is acceptable for use as a surface lubricant used in the manufacture of metallic articles (P1) as described in 21 CFR 178.3910, used to facilitate the drawing, stamping, and forming of metallic articles from rolled foil and sheet stock provided that total residual lubricant remaining on the metallic article in the form in which it contacts food does not exceed 0.2 milligram per square inch of food-contact surface. The amount used should be the minimum required to accomplish the desired technical effect and shall not accomplish any technical effect in the food itself.**
