NSF has processed the application for Registration of **QFW1800** to the *NSF International Registration Guidelines for Proprietary Substances and Nonfood Compounds* (2017), which are available upon request by contacting NonFood@nsf.org. The NSF Nonfood Compounds Registration Program is a continuation of the USDA product approval and listing program, which is based on meeting regulatory requirements including FDA 21 CFR for appropriate use, ingredient and labeling review.

This device is acceptable for use as an ozone generating device providing sanitation and disinfection to hard, inanimate, pre-cleaned surfaces, in and around food processing areas (P1). A potable water rinse is not required following the use of this device on previously cleaned hard surfaces provided that the surfaces are adequately drained before contact with food. The device must only be used in a manner consistent with the manufacturer's labeling and use instructions.

This device is acceptable for use as an ozone generating device providing general cleaning to all surfaces in and around food processing areas, where its use is not intended for direct food contact (P1). When used as a general cleaning product, rinsing of cleaned surfaces with the ozonated solution is required. The device must only be used in a manner consistent with the manufacturer's labeling and use instructions.
